## 2024 LWLA Projects:

Myers Road/Waneta Terrace Project June 5, 2024: Installing a series of engineered rock riffles to stabilize the incising stream bed along the road. Engineered rock riffles, are large pieces of flat rip rap, that are laid in compression. Similar to dominoes that are tipped over. This allows the bottom to stop eroding and will lead to more stability of the eroding banks of the stream. These structures will be placed in series along the stream in varying distances, and will run bank to bank. (they work similar to check dams) (Waneta Terrace LLC contributed \$5,000 and LWLA contributed \$10,000 to the project.)
